FISHING SCHEDULE

HALF-DAY FLUKE FISHING (May through August)

8 AM - 12:30 PM and 2 PM - 6:30 PM

These 4½-hour fishing trips are fun for the whole family. From the novice to the pro everyone will enjoy catching these tasty fish. Our trips usually find us fishing within a ½-hour from the dock in local, shallow waters with great results.



Fish range in size from 1½ pounds all the way up to 12 pound. "doormats". Fluke fishing is during the warm summer months, so while riding to the grounds, you can relax on our sundeck and enjoy the weather. No reservations required.

HALF-NIGHT BLUEFISHING (June, July, and August) Friday and Saturday Nights

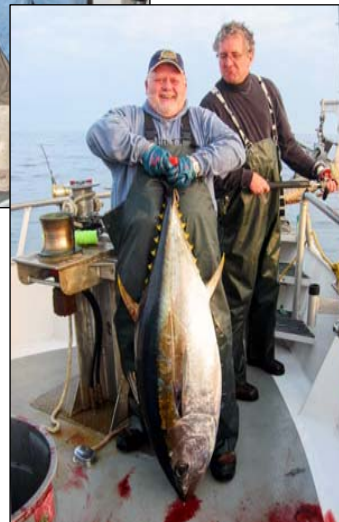
Our night trips for Bluefish give you the chance to battle one of the areas toughest game fish. Bluefish range from two to 15 pounds and are often plentiful in our waters. It is not uncommon for many anglers to catch limit catches on these trips. Bluefish trips appeal to both seasoned veterans and first timers. We leave at 7:30 PM and return between 12:30 and 1 AM. Alcohol is strictly limited on these trips to promote a family atmosphere. No reservations required.

OVERNIGHT CANYON TUNA 24 Person Limit (Late August through Mid-November)



We leave the dock at 5:00 PM (6:00 PM in November) and return at approximately 3:00 PM the following day. These trips offer excitement,

sport and the ultimate in fishing challenges. We travel 4 to 5 hours to the canyons at the edge of the continental shelf where we catch Yellowfin, Big Eye and Albacore tuna



as well as Mahi-Mahi, Mako sharks and the ultimate prize, the Swordfish. These trips are recommended for anglers with moderate experience who are in good physical condition. Reservations are required.

OFFSHORE JUMBO SEA BASS (Mid-November through March)

Our wreck trips offer anglers the opportunity to fish sunken wrecks located approximately 50 to 80 miles off the New Jersey coast. The boat departs at 11:30 PM and returns the following day at around 6:00 PM. A wide variety of fish can be found on these wrecks.



Our catch is generally Sea Bass but we also catch Cod, Pollock and Porgies. All of the fish we catch on these trips are excellent table fare and limit catches are common. Reservations are required.





DIRECTIONS to THE VOYAGER

From Northern New Jersey...

NJ Turnpike to exit 11 and get on Garden State Parkway South

Take Parkway South to EXIT 98

Stay on left side of exit ramp to Route 34 South. (Route 34 South becomes Route 35 South.)

Stay in left lane of 35 South and go over Manasquan River drawbridge. Follow signs for Broadway, Beach Area. (About ¼-mile past bridge, make left lane U-turn to Route 35 North.)

Stay in right lane on Route 35 North and turn right onto Broadway.

Make first left turn onto Channel Drive.

Our dock at Fishermen's Supply Co. is about ½-mile on your left at 69 Channel Drive.

From Southern New Jersey...

Take the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 90. This will put you on Chambersbridge Road.

Take Chambersbridge Road to Route 70 East and then to Route 35 South.

Stay in left lane of 35 South and go over Manasquan River drawbridge. Follow signs for Broadway, Beach Area. (About ¼-mile past bridge, make left lane U-turn to Route 35 North.)

Stay in right lane on Route 35 North and turn right onto Broadway.

Make first left turn onto Channel Drive.

Our dock at Fishermen's Supply Co. is about ½-mile on your left at 69 Channel Drive.

From Western New Jersey...

Route 70 East to Route 35 South.

Stay in left lane of 35 South and go over Manasquan River drawbridge. Follow signs for Broadway, Beach Area. (About ¼-mile past bridge, make left lane U-turn to Route 35 North.)

Stay in right lane on Route 35 North and turn right onto Broadway.

Make first left turn onto Channel Drive.

Our dock at Fishermen's Supply Co. is about ½-mile on your left at 69 Channel Drive.
